Once the Headmaster has approved the enrolment based on details of your son's schooling to date, to complete the enrolment process **\$NZ33,310** should be paid to Account 01 0681 0007274 00. This is the account of the Huntley School Board of Trustees at the ANZ Bank in Marton, New Zealand. Once paid a receipt will be issued and a place reserved for your son.

Note: 1. Insurance, uniform, holiday travel and homestays, musical instrument tuition, personal expenses (see attached summary).

Summary of expected costs covered by the NZ\$5,500 deposit:

Insurance	NZ \$550 – \$ 600 Approximately Personal Insurance Policy from Vero or Southern Cross
Uniform	NZ \$1,800 - \$2,000 if all items purchased are new.
	NZ\$900 - \$1,400 if a mixture of new and second hand clothing is purchased.
	NZ \$700 - \$900 if the majority of the uniform purchased is second hand.

We can arrange to sell the uniform for parents when the student finishes Huntley School. We would then send a credit to the pupil's new school or a cheque directly to the parents.



Weekend leave & school holidays (2010)

NZ \$60 per leave weekend (\$30 per night)

There are usually eight weekend leave weekends per year, therefore the cost is \$480 per year.

NZ \$210 per week in the holidays

There are nine weeks of holidays per year not including the Christmas holidays. **It is recommended that the International Student either goes home for at least one of these holidays or that his parents come to NZ and look after him for one of the holidays** there may be up to 6 weeks of holiday home stay payments required. This is deducted from the incidental account.

Personal Expenses

It is up to the parents to determine how much money they want their sons to have to spend on leave weekends and in the holidays. At times home stay families may request more money to cover holiday travel or activities. Parent permission will always be asked for before approving any expenditure over and above what is provided for home stay families.

Note 2: Airfares

The school does not arrange flights for the boys. We do of course, confirm tickets, and deliver and pick up boys from the Palmerston North Airport. It is advisable to check term dates carefully with the school and then book tickets early as there is often a high demand for flights near school holiday periods.

Note 3: Visas

Permanent Resident Visas are not relevant to our acceptance of an overseas student. If a boy requires ESOL teaching and/or our home stay services, the overseas student fee is payable irrespective of visa status.
